Zoe Dryden is a business advisor, leadership coach and facilitator with a unique business and personal development perspective. Zoe has spent 27 years owning and successfully co-running her own companies spanning multiple industries including Port and Logistics, Sports, Tourism, and Education, whilst simultaneously learning, training and self-applying the work of personal leadership and growth.

Originally with an academic background and a post-graduate degree in business, Zoe was a lecturer in Strategy overseeing the Master's in Management programme at Victoria University, before becoming a management consultant. With this early entry into business leadership and company growth, Zoe immersed herself in organisational and culture change principles to balance out her business acumen. This saw her training in values-based leadership work, culture change and human potential. Zoe then founded Second Base Ltd which became one of the pioneer companies leading self-awareness, purpose-centric leadership, and well-being. Her original offering was a flag-ship programme of leadership training based in the Himalayas. This programme merged social and commercial intentions and was set-up to demonstrate the ease and power of impact learning. Second Base has gained widespread media attention and won international awards and is now known as one of New Zealand's most regarded leadership coaches with clients in NZ, Australia and UK.

Throughout this time Zoe founded a charity in Nepal, FACE Nepal, and led the development of women's groups and mentoring programmes in the Chitwan region, building schools, running volunteering, sponsoring children and various other community-driven projects. This charity operates today under both a local board and has registration is UK, NZ and Nepal.

Today Zoe works primarily in governance and continues to provide strategy support/troubleshooting advice, business oversight and leadership coaching to select companies. She designs workshops based on expressed needs and delivers one-to-one support customised to the individual.



**SKILLS:** Zoe's skill is understanding exactly where a business, project or person is at and where they want to be, and identifying the actions and learnings needed to move it all forward in a grounded and practical way. This includes the development of the skills and qualities of leadership to pull it all off. She is passionate and purpose-driven and balances the holistic and practical aspects of change. This is demonstrated in the success she has in her own businesses as well as the impact with clients she works with. She has a knowledge of both business and personal development and has achieved recognition and media attention for both her businesses, and her personal achievements.

With her depth of tools and experience most of her programmes are customised to suit, and often delivered spontaneously in response to the needs uncovered – she goes "live". With her practical background in blue-collar industries and personal business achievements, she can deliver an inspiring personal story and a straight-shooting style that is respected from governance level to shop floor.

**PUBLIC SPEAKING:** Zoe is an accomplished speaker, often employed for her impact as a woman in business, or as an inspirational business speaker for her work in Nepal. Zoe also leads leadership speaking events/group workshops, with clients including Icehouse, presenting Leadership in Action and behaviour training and tools. Her skill in these events is her relatability and her extensive knowledge that enables her to be present with an audience and respond in the moment to the needs of the attendees with relevant and practical steps.

**ADVISORY AND PARTNERSHIP SUPPORT:** Zoe works in a guidance role as a business partner to an owner, CEO or Managing Director within companies on fixed-term basis during times of change or growth. She can step in as an external viewpoint, connecting with employees to forward their growth, running team-based strategy work to engage departments in bigger picture direction, and working alongside an owner to provide personal guidance as they navigate change. Zoe also provides guidance into a board, to help identify where cultural change is needed to effect organisational goals and get behind the boldness needed during times of trouble-shooting or transformation.
